

Where to Add Workforce Identity Verification (and Why)

Impersonation attacks succeed when workforce identity systems assume too much trust. This guide shows where IT and security teams can prevent these attacks by strategically adding workforce identity verification checkpoints at critical moments, without adding friction everywhere.

Start with this question






Effective workforce identity verification deployments start with one simple question:

If this action were abused, could it cause real damage?

If the answer is yes, the person behind the action should be verified. This approach allows teams to enhance security and reduce risk, without impacting everyday work.

Where to add identity verification

These are the moments attackers target, and where identity verification has the greatest impact:

-  **Account Recovery & Helpdesk**
Attackers impersonate locked-out employees to gain access by resetting passwords or MFA.
-  **Hiring & Remote Onboarding**
Bad actors use fake or stolen identities to get hired, then receive legitimate credentials and devices.
-  **Privilege & Role Changes**
Attackers exploit trusted access requests to escalate privileges and expand control.
-  **High-Risk Approvals**
Deepfakes and social engineering trick employees into approving payments or account changes.
-  **AI Agent Actions**
Autonomous agents act without clear human accountability, increasing risk.

What changes with workforce identity verification

- ✓ Impersonation attacks are stopped earlier
- ✓ MFA recovery and onboarding flows are secured
- ✓ Support teams spend less time interrogating, more time helping
- ✓ Video verification calls are reduced or eliminated entirely
- ✓ High-risk actions have clear accountability

The takeaway

Reducing impersonation isn't about verifying everyone's identity all the time. It's about verifying the right person at the right moment.
